Production dates: February 27 and 28, 2015 or March 6 and 7, 2015

Dress Rehearsal dates: February 25 and 26 or March 4 or 5, 2015)

Who can audition: Anyone between the ages of 7 to 18 years, who can sing, dance and act

Required Class: Must be enrolled in a Musical Theatre class.
(fee incorporated in the regular school fee structure)

Production Class: 2 hours every Saturday afternoon (3:30pm - 5:30pm)
There will be NO make-up lessons if a student misses any class(es).

Production Fee: \$350.00 (6 months/20 hours of class time)

Fee includes: headshot, actor's book and family matters, show DVD, cast party

Fee structure: \$150.00 upon registration and casting (**non-refundable/non-transferable**)
\$200.00 post-dated to September 15, 2014

Costume Fee: \$150.00 post-dated to September 15, 2014 (fee can increase depending on the number of roles in which a participant is cast.
Additional \$20 - \$25 may be collected for wig rental (TBD)

Volunteer Fee: \$100.00 post dated to March 7, 2015 (per family)
